Overall Objectives

- 1. To deliver Level Playing Field Access Audits.
- 2. To undertake design appraisals of sports venues.
- 3. Securing new audit commissions in the sports sector.
- 4. Supporting fans and clubs with their general enquiries.
- 5. To maintain Level Playing Field's reputation of excellence with its stakeholders.

Specific Responsibilities

- 1. To undertake a programme of Access Audits and design appraisals of sports venues within given timescales as part of the access team.
- 2. To provide recommendations within the audit reports that improve access and inclusion for disabled sports spectators.
- 3. Promote Level Playing Field's audits with clubs, governing bodies, and other organisations and secure new commissions.
- 4. Working with and building positive relationships with the LPF membership, disabled supporters, clubs, and other key stake holders.
- 5. To represent Level Playing Field at Conferences, Forums, Meetings, and other relevant events.
- 6. Handling day-to-day enquiries from clubs and disabled supporters.
- 7. To play an active role in delivering aspects of Level Playing Field's annual national campaign, Weeks of Action.
