As part of our continuing growth, we want to appoint a new Fan Engagement & Enquiry Officer. The successful candidate will work alongside the Fans Liaison Officer & Development Officer to deliver key areas of our fan engagement activities.

Principal responsibilities will include supporting and facilitating proactive engagement with disabled supporters and Disabled Supporters' Associations (DSAs), as well as being a point of contact for disabled fans and other stakeholders.

Candidates must have the ability to engage with a wide range of stakeholders and be passionate about making live sport more inclusive and accessible for disabled sports fans to attend.

Specific duties include: logging and processing enquiries, liaising with fans and clubs to suitably resolve key issues and complaints, playing an active role in reviewing and updating fan and club information pages on the Level Playing Field website, and ensuring fans have access to up-to-date information.

Candidates must be computer literate, able to manage multiple projects simultaneously, and be able to communicate clearly and sensitively.

This position is a hybrid role, with the option of working from home or at a local office space, the cost of which would be covered by Level Playing Field. The charity will, of course, provide any equipment required for the Fan Engagement & Enquiry Officer to successfully deliver their role. The role requires some travel across England and Wales, including regular in-person regional team meetings.
