Role Purpose:

- To take responsibility for your own performance, training and continuous professional development
- To carry out risk assessments and report any incidents / accidents to the line manager immediately.
- Signposting players through the Aston Villa Foundation agreed Player Pathway.
- Take responsibility on your sessions and activities for critical business functions such as human resources, health and Safety, safeguarding and equality and diversity ensuring compliance with Aston Villa Foundation policies, legislation and best practice.
- Any other reasonable duties and responsibilities which your line manager or another senior officer at the club asks you to perform
