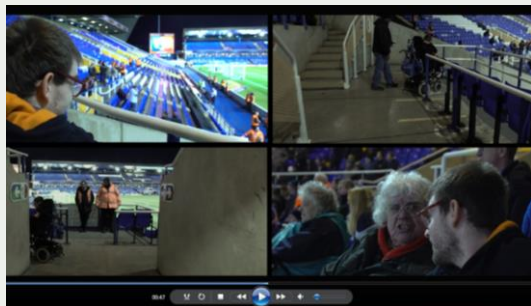
Club Video Birmingham City
